The Bible and Prophecy

Remember - What have we forgotten? A 6000 year old remedy for tension.

1. What was at the centre of the 3 angels message?

Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters. Revelation 14:6-7

2. How much did God create?

Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created things, Revelation 4:11

3. When should we worship God?

Remember the day, to keep it holy. Exodus 20:8

4. Why should we worship God on this day?

For *in* six days the LORD heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them. Exodus 20:11

5. Who was the Sabbath made for?

The Sabbath was made for, and not for the Sabbath: Mark 2:27

6. What did God do on the seventh day?

And he on the seventh day from all his work which he had made. Genesis 2:2

10. What does God say the Sabbath will be?

Moreover also I gave them my Sabbaths, to be a between me and them. Ezekiel 20:12

NOTE: Jesus was crucified on Friday (preparation), the day before the Sabbath (Mark 15:42). Jesus rested in the tomb on the Sabbath of the commandment (Luke 23:56), then rose on the first day—the day after the Sabbath (Mark 16:1-6). Christians around the world still celebrate that day as Easter Sunday. The Bible clearly shows that the Sabbath was the day after Friday and the day before Sunday. It's easy to locate that day of the week on any calendar.
